RED BLUFF FACILITY

Jeri spoke with Mandy at Red Bluff in regards to our concerns about the use of their facility. Mandy feels that most of the footing problems can be addressed. They have installed fans in the indoor arena and have a total of 200 stalls. This includes the stalls by the racetrack. They have the capacity for 100 trailers to hook up to power and water.

The cost for stalls to us would be \$80 for a week and the same for the RV spaces. The cost for the arenas (3) would be \$1500 per day. The club would have the option of running a food booth or they would run the booth and comp food for the people that work for the show. They would also contact local companies to come in and set up vendor booths. Comfort Inn would be the host hotel and offer 10% off and comp the Judges rooms.

CORNING FACILITY

Brandi gave the club an overview of numbers provided by the Corning facility. At this point these are "soft" numbers that will be confirmed before the next

meeting. The facility has 2 covered arenas, two outdoor arenas, 300 matted stalls. They will work the arenas as needed. A block of rooms will be reserved for show participants. The Corning facility would take care of all of the RV reservations and the shavings so neither one of the clubs would have to worry about that part of it. There is a concern that there are no poles available but this may be able to be resolved by members bringing the needed items to the facility.

It was decided by the members present that we should move forward with the event being held at the Corning facility and all cost split with the San Joaquin Club.

The next step is to look at the cost for judges and get them hired for the show.

We would like to remind everyone that we will be sending out ballots for new officers and board members in November. If you would like to nominate someone please contact any of the current officers.
